

Forecast Highlights

- Forecast on Target
 - Conservative Approach to Development of Forecast
 - Overall revenues and expenditures projected to be within 2% of November Forecast
 - Cash Balance projected to increase roughly 3.2% by June 30th.
- Unrestricted Grants-in-Aide (State Foundation Funds)
 - Fair School Funding Plan
 - Phased in by 1/6th of the total plan in Fiscal Year 2021-22 and 2022-23. No promise that the phase in will continue.

Fiscal Year 2022-23 Budget Update

- As presented on the current Five-Year Forecast (2023 Column)
- Revenues
 - Budgeted overall operating revenue decrease of roughly 1.7% (\$4.7 million)
 - HB 126 eliminates direct payments
 - Medicaid reconciliation process backlog clearing up
 - Two payments of roughly \$1 million each in Fiscal Year 2021-22. One anticipated in Fiscal Year 2022-23.

Expenditures

- Budgeted overall operating expenditures increase of roughly 3.6% (\$9.9 million)
- Staffing levels maintained at current levels with small adjustments
- Collective Bargaining Agreements
 - OAPSE budgeted for the next three years
 - SWEA and SWAA expire on June 30, 2022
- Health Insurance increased 6% effective January 1, 2022
- Building and Department Budgets remain flat based
- Final Approval at the June 27th Board of Education Meeting
